Meal Plans are **pre-paid** by automatic bank withdrawal on the first day of each month with your rent.

·Plan A - 3 meals - \$950 per month

- o 3 meals per day (Breakfast, Lunch, and Dinner)
- o unlimited tea, coffee, and hot chocolate
- o one snack <u>per day</u> (muffin, daily cake special, or comparable item)
- o one small juice per day.

·Plan B - 2 meals - \$645 per month

- o 2 meals per day (Breakfast or Lunch, and Dinner)
- o unlimited tea, coffee, and hot chocolate
- o one snack <u>per day</u> (muffin, daily cake special, or comparable item)
- o one small juice per day.

If you choose a Meal Plan, we will provide a <u>St. Andrew's Centre swipe card</u> to be presented at the *Garden Café* cash register when ordering your qualifying Meal Plan purchases.

Garden Café purchases not included in the Meal Plan are recorded and invoiced at the end of each calendar month. These billings are payable on receipt, at the Main Office using debit card, credit card, cash, or automatic bank withdrawal (Pre-Authorized Payment or "PAP") if preferred.







FALL


The Autumn Equinox is Sunday, September 22 at 6:43 AM. It occurs at the same moment worldwide for the Northern Hemisphere.
