#### **Greetings from the Chief Operating Officer,**

I trust this letter finds you well. As part of our ongoing commitment to maintaining a safe, respectful, and healthy living environment for all residents and staff, I am writing to reaffirm several policies that are critical to the wellbeing of our community. Your cooperation and adherence to these policies are not only expected but essential to ensuring St. Andrew's Centre continues to be a place of comfort, dignity, and mutual respect.

First, I would like to address an issue of utmost importance. St. Andrew's Centre enforces a **strict zero-tolerance policy regarding harassment**. All forms of harassment whether verbal, physical, emotional, or psychological directed at staff, fellow residents, or visitors will not be tolerated under any circumstance. This includes, but is not limited to, inappropriate language, intimidation, threats, or any behaviour that creates a hostile or uncomfortable environment. **Any resident found to be in violation of this policy will be subject to formal documentation, and such incidents may lead to non-renewal of lease agreements.** Our staff and residents deserve to interact in a community that is grounded in courtesy, professionalism, and mutual respect.

Secondly, I must reiterate the Centre's policy on smoking. In accordance with provincial health regulations and our internal safety standards, **smoking is strictly prohibited inside residential suites**, **on balconies**, **and in all indoor areas of the building.** This includes tobacco products, cannabis, and electronic vaping devices. Smoking is permitted only in clearly marked designated outdoor areas. **Any violation of this policy will be documented**, **and repeated non-compliance will result in non-renewal of your lease**. This policy is enforced to protect the health of all residents and staff, especially those with respiratory or medical sensitivities.

Please also be advised that the main office will be closed on Monday, August 4th in observance of Heritage Day. Should you require urgent assistance on that day, please contact Security, who will be on site and available to support residents as needed.

St. Andrew's Centre remains committed to creating a safe and respectful home for all who live and work here. These policies are in place to preserve the quality of life we strive to provide, and we rely on the cooperation of every resident to uphold them.

#### **IMPORTANT INFORMATION ON SMOKING POLICY**

To clarify our policy regarding cigarette and marijuana smoking: St. Andrew's is not classified as a smoke-free environment, which means that smokers are permitted. We allow smokers to lease suites because we cannot discriminate against personal choices. However, we do enforce strict guidelines regarding smoking, which are as follows:

- NO RESIDENT, GUEST, VISITOR, OR STAFF MEMBER MAY SMOKE CIGARETTES ANYWHERE IN THE BUILDING OR ON THE PROPERTY, EXCEPT IN THE DESIGNATED SMOKING AREA AT THE FRONT OF THE BUILDING.
- SMOKING MARIJUANA (INCLUDING FOR MEDICAL USE) MUST OCCUR OFF THE PREMISES.

Any individual who does not comply with these policies will face potential non-renewal of their lease agreement and may be asked to vacate their suite. All residents are accountable for their guests and visitors; if they fail to adhere to this policy, the resident may also be considered for non-renewal.

We take this policy seriously, and we expect that if you observe anyone violating it, you will report it to security or the management team. Your report will be kept confidential.

Please note that starting February 1, 2026, the designated smoking area at the front of the building will be eliminated, and all individuals who smoke must leave the property. Failure to comply will result in non-renewal of their lease—no exceptions!

#### Debit Card is our preferred method of payment.


It is very quick and convenient for you and for our staff, and it's less costly for the Centre to process compared to credit card, cash, or PAP transactions.






#### SUSAN'S NEWS
